Condemning what he called 'brutal force' on the protesters who were demanding the bodies of the seven militants, Geelani claimed that the way bodies were refused to be handed over the militants indicate that the authorities are trying to cover up the truth. He stated further that the independent international organizations must probe into the killings so that the truth could be unmasked at
